



## **SELECTION CRITERIA AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED**

The recipient will be selected based on academic achievement, community service and financial need. An interview will be conducted. Scholarship amounts will be determined annually by A.B.L.E.

### **To be considered by A.B.L.E. the candidate must:**

- Be attending or plan to attend an accredited College or University
- Provide proof of acceptance to or present status at an accredited College or University
- Provide transcripts of current academic standing
- Provide a letter of support from a community agency or organization where volunteer work is done
- Submit an essay 500 words, in length, typed, double spaced on one (1) of the following topics:
  - Outline your voluntary service to the community
  - Why you have chosen your particular field of study and how your chosen career will make a positive contribution to the community
  - Why you should be selected as an A.B.L.E. award recipient
- Candidates must be of good moral character and habits and willing to volunteer with A.B.L.E. for a minimum of two years

A.B.L.E. on or before Friday, March 8, 2019 to be considered.**
